



POSTPONED: CFUNITED 2020 | DETROIT | APRIL 5-7

Statement Release: Tuesday, March 10, 2020; 3:00 pm EDT

Dear CFUnited Community,

Due to rapidly escalating health concerns relating to the spread of COVID-19 (coronavirus), CFUnited has decided to postpone the 2020 conference that was scheduled to take place April 5-7, 2020 in Detroit, MI. The decision to postpone CFUnited 2020 was not taken lightly. The health, safety and well-being of our attendees, speakers, sponsors, exhibitors and staff is of paramount importance. We recognize and acknowledge the inconvenience this postponement may cause. However, this decision was made out of concern for the health and well-being of our attendees, staff, and the Detroit community.

At the onset of planning for CFUnited 2020, we established a decision framework that ensures the values and best interests of all stakeholders is woven into every decision we make. As we begin the work of rescheduling the conference, we will continue to use this framework to mitigate, as best we can, the impact to your experience as an attendee, speaker, or sponsor/exhibitor; ensure the continuity of the overall program; and limit the financial exposure to all stakeholders.

The CFUnited partner organizations, AdNet, Comma, Council on Foundations and ProNet, who lead the Conference Committee are working to determine new conference dates. With over 450 registered attendees, more than 85 presenters, 25 sponsors and exhibitors, it is critical that our approach to rescheduling takes into consideration each of our stakeholders. You can expect to hear from us in the next two to three weeks with a new date and further details regarding the rescheduling of the conference and registration refund information. In the meantime, we encourage you to reach out to us at info@cfunited.org with your questions, comments and concerns.

On behalf of the CFUnited Conference Committee and the partner organizations, we appreciate your patience and understanding as we work through our plans to reschedule the conference. We look forward to seeing you later this year. Together we will create space to dig into the unique role you and your organization play in harnessing the power of place.
